We feel that health is one of the most vital areas for the poor people to look into and to uplift themselves so that they may become better citizens in order to serve the nation. The Franciscans of St. John the Baptist society's main areas of concern the poor of interior Sindh, namely Khipro, Matli and its surroundings. We are on the opinion that the poor can have better treatment with regard to their health issues.

The second area of our concern is the education of the poor children. The Franciscans of St. John the Baptist look after the education of the youth in two major cities of Pakistan namely Lahore and Karachi where they get full scholarships of boarding and lodging. INTRODUCTION:

Franciscans of St John the Baptist, Pakistan was registered on March 10, 2000, under Societies, (XXI Act of 1860). The Society of Franciscans of St John the Baptist, Pakistan runs on a charitable basis and the welfare of the members.

It is a non-profitable, non-commercial, and non-religious basis. It also trains youth intellectually, spiritually, and culturally to be of service of the people in their surroundings and in Sindh Province/Pakistan as a whole.

The main purpose of the society is to spread education, health facilities, and charitable works for the less advantaged people. Since then it is working actively in three sectors of human life, as follows: Health, Education, Charity. During the Board of Directors meeting there were discussions in groups and afterward there was a presentation of every report. The purpose of these deliberations was to facilitate the formulation of a mandate for the up-coming new board members of the organization of Franciscans of St John the Baptist, Pakistan.

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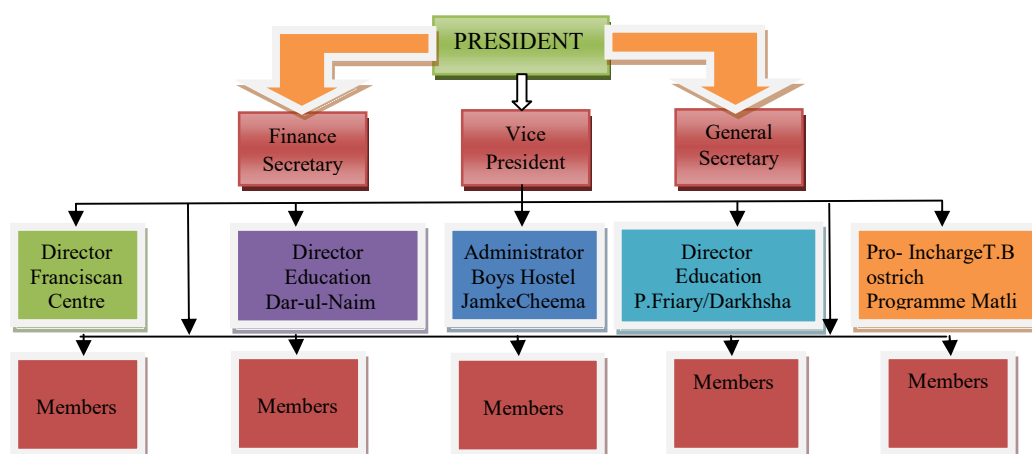

ORGANIZATIONAL STRUCTURE



Vision:

Bring love, joy, hope and a better life through the means of Education for their children and families to overcome the poverty and injustices of their lives and to become better persons. The vision for future plan of the organization is to serve and to minister to their needs, the first and the most important is to promote Education.

The second is the religious education formation and the third is to give Health education and helping in the health issues. As a organization of Franciscans of St. John the Baptist Pakistan we must continue to serve those who are extremely poor, marginalized and on the peripheries of the society.

Mission:

Education: Education is our first priority: to educate our children through our village schools but the parents need motivation to send their children (boys/girls) to school for the education. We Franciscans provide school material and scholarship funds for their primary school education, high school education, and college education and for religious education and professional training.

Health Care: We helped the emergency medical cases of families because they don't have enough money to pay for their long treatments.

Community Building:For women we provide sewing machines and training for stitching clothes in order to support their families, giving help for burnt houses or in any emergency, supporting vocational training and professional training programmes.

Pastoral Care and Catechism:Thus through our sacramental ministry, giving catechesis through audio/video material and celebrating the Eucharist every day and on the big feasts days in order to give them a real foundation of faith; but it demands more effort and commitment.

Programmes /Activities

Introduction

I am a medical nurse. I work as a pastoral worker and nurse in health ministry in Hyderabad diocese. This diocese has five tribal parishes; one of them is run by us Franciscans. I mainly work in Khipro and Matli parishes. Health ministry is part of the tribal Apostolate in Hyderabad diocese. I am lucky to have the nursing degree so that as a trained nurse I got the opportunity to respond to my vocation and to live meaningfully as a friar minor.

Over the years the work has grown and so too I myself have gained confidence. The work involves much treatment of different sicknesses mainly tuberculosis. We need to have a regular follow up of these tuberculosis patients who are under treatment with us. My work for the poor flows from my relationship with God. This allows me to have a clear vision to opt to help the poor and the under-privileged.



We welcome all people in the health programme. We hope all who come for the health programme would complete their treatment and be preserved from the diseases.

The main beneficiaries are the local people with whom we have regular contact in our areas.

I work in different health areas:

- Tuberculosis, cure and prevention
- Health awareness in outreach
- Local waterfilter method
- Bring patients to various hospitals
- Abuse of drug users
- Under age marriages
- Medical camps
- Community development

I must admit that at the beginning it was very hard to know what one wants, or what God wants. Only the time and experience will indicate the right direction. I feel that this is a wonderful ministry where I have the privilege to touch the wounds of people and help them become well again. I now can imagine St. Francis embracing the leper with joy and with his heart.

In the healing ministry we encourage the patients to have a good treatment and be cured from the disease and save their life and family.



It gives me hope and tremendous joy, when I see patients who were close to death at one time, and after being taken care of, get cured and becomes a source of life for the family again. It feels as if a new life is returned not only to this person who was sick and is well now, but the whole family gets new life through this healing ministry. What a wonder! This is how I play my role in the Kingdom of God.



Outcome

People are very helpful and look forward to learn about better health care. Many of them also indicate other families who have the same disease. Thus this helps us to reach out to others as well. At the end I would like to say that though the challenge is there, with small steps we are succeeding in animating individuals and families to take care of their health. I believe that prevention is better than cure, which we stress in our health programme.

I want to thank my fellow friars and other friends who support and constantly encourage me to carry on this important ministry. I also thank the donors who very generously support this healing ministry.

S t. Mary's Boys Hostel, JamkeCheema, Sialkot.

The friars of St.John the Baptist Custody, Pakistan have been looking after the boy's hostel for many years, ever since we took responsibility for St.Mary's Parish, JamkeCheema, Sialkot, Pakistan. There is a local staff of cook, warden and a tuition teacher who work together with me. Our main responsibility is to look after the holistic formation and specifically making sure that they are growing in their studies at school as well as their proper and healthier food and time-table that the boys make progress in their future life.

There are 50 boys in the hostel and hopefully the number will increase after the academic year. The time-table is organized in such a way that they have ample time for their studies, and other extracurricular activities.

We emphasize a lot on academic discipline; we help them in various activities to improve their self-confidence. We develop good attitudes, behaviors and manners in their everyday life. We organize various character building activities for self-grooming and confidence. Catechism classes are arranged every weekend and on Saturdays and Fridays the boys learn daily prayers, recite the rosary, sing hymns and read a short story in the Bible and on Sundays the bigger boy's do scripture reading. Every morning they attend mass, they do bible reading, altar serving, and choir. Every Friday they attend English mass. Along with these, we also emphasize social activities, sports, art and craft skills for their overall improvement.



They go to school every day and Friday afternoon and Sunday are free. We use this time to give them catechetical instructions. They also do house work themselves, cleaning the place, looking after the garden, helping the cook, washing their clothes, tidying the rest rooms and dormitories.

The boys have to spend at least three hours every day at their studies. Weak students are helped with extra coaching classes. They do have sufficient time for games and physical exercise, football, cricket and volleyball are liked very much. We carried on the custom of celebrating Easter and Christmas and this year as well students celebrated and students made beautiful cards, played nativity dramas in English.

Teacher and parents appreciated them so much. We feel we have achieved quite success, the boys are learning, growing and becoming self-confident.

We encourage students to speak English in the school and hostel too. English classes are arranged in the hostel. We give them short essays to read. We help them to improve their handwriting. We also taught them prayers of Saint Francis, such as most high, glorious God, we adore you and peace prayer of Saint Francis.



We are now looking to improve hostel building. It is in bad shape. The roofs of the dormitories are made of iron sheet that is why in summer rooms become very hot. During rain roof leaks and makes the rooms filthy. We have talked to bishop and the bishop has promised to do something. We are trying our level best to provide good atmosphere.

Our main problems are the hostel building and fees are not paid by all and often paid late. We remain patient with the parents. All our boys benefit from the hostel and school. We invite poor and deserving children to get education and move in bright future.

We are paying more attention on their academic studies we had good result of metric students. They got good marks and position. Almost all students have passed their schooling and gone to the next level. We have made plan on their regular studies and holistic formation. These will help them in their future life.

I would like to thank the fraternity for giving me this opportunity to serve in the apostolate of education and formation of the Christian deserving students.

After the reports were presented they were discussed in the plenary session that followed, the points that emerged are as follows:

Is it possible for the hostels ministers to come together and make a common plan in line with Franciscan values?

We need to strengthen the special ministries the friars are involved in. one of the suggestions was if the custody can own the ministries and develop our own structures.

There was also a question how the finances are arranged and dealt with. For the most part, the order supports them with the help of MZF.

For the T.B. outreach program we have collaboration with the Columbans and the Mill Hills, which was not mentioned in the report.

Nature of the ministry creates confusion because we are working for other people and are simply providing personnel.

PROGRESS

EXTRA COACHING CLASSES FOCUSING SCHOOL CURRICULUM

Daily extra coaching classes are provided to the children on daily basis. A trained teacher provides the students coaching 2 hours daily.

1. COMPUTER COACHING

A professional teacher is hired for the computer coaching to the students of class 6th to 10th.

2. REGULAR CATECHISM CLASSES

Month of October every day children prayed Rosary.

3. CAREER GUIDANCE AND EXPOSURE VISIT

During the reporting period 2 career guidance workshop were organized 1 in Hostel and 1 in Caritas Pakistan Hyderabad Officer. Over-all 34 children participated in these workshops.

4. AWARENESS ON CLIMATE CHANGE AND ENVIRONMENT

To build the awareness of children on climate change and environment problem. Student start sowing and planting trees. Over student distribution three other group and school and helping government agencies about nine hundred trees a givens.

5. LIFE SKILLS

Every day the high school children carry out one hour's work in the garden in the church compound, church building children the clean. A physical activity that nurtures soul, mind and body.

6. SPORTS ACTIVITIES

Daily 1 hour is scheduled for sports activities for the students for the better mental and physical growth of children.

Conclusion

I find that this is a great opportunity and opening for us friars in coordination with our Franciscan Charism, to work with the people at the periphery. I or even someone else works, but I would suggest two friars to be engage in this fruitful ministry.

Dar-ul-Naim-Lahore

This report consists of three years activities and life of Franciscan houses of formation in the Custody of St. John the Baptist Pakistan from the years 2017-2020. There are three houses of formation, Dar-ul-Naim, the initial formation house Lahore, Darakhshan; Novitiate House Karachi and Portiuncula Friary; A post Novitiate House Karachi includes On-going and Vocation Commissions.

Dar-ul-Naim is the initial formation house in Lahore and the candidates stay under formation for three to four years. Normally the candidates come to join after matriculation or intermediate in their teen ages. We have a three years regular program in the house including postulancy classes. The third-year students go outside the house for college classes; recently they have started going to the diocesan seminary for intermediate classes. The teaching staff in our formation house is hard working and committed to their respective jobs. And the environment of the house is healthy and peaceful. The main concern is the basic faith formation and academics progress of the candidates which includes human, Christian and Franciscan perspectives of formation.

The formation team includes three friars initially Fr. David Mughal, Fr. Eric Rassani and Fr. Victor John Fr. Dildar Michael also joined in January 2019. The formation team aims to encourage candidates to grow in the Franciscan spirit, engaged in activities, fulfilling demands, and hopes, trying to achieve their goals, at all levels of formation in the house. The formation team tries to make the formation house a healthy Franciscan place for the young candidates where they can see themselves as followers of St. Francis. Friars accompany and ensure support to the young candidates. They share responsibilities to make the house and formation program successful.

During these years Dar-ul-Naim has been working to attain some possible goals which were set for better formation, for example, living in Franciscan spirit, spirit of prayer, brotherhood, developing English and Urdu languages, cooperation, mutual support, following the time table, personal discipline, personal awareness, progress in faith, openness, development of personal talents, attending community activities, love for creation, taking responsibilities, taking initiatives, etc. Mostly the postulants were given big responsibilities for the exposures and the younger brothers were fixed with them to learn from the experienced.

During this term the director of Dar-ul-Naim was asked to evaluate the formation program and find out possible ways for its progress. The director of formation had presented four models of proposals before the team of formators for discussion. They came up with result that present structure is suitable but we need to make it more effective and need to own it. There is no need to make any other move, since our formation is different in its nature.

Darakhshan House Karachi Progress Report

Fr. Azeem Lawrence the Novice master is accompanied by Br. Francis Matsumoto in Darakhshan. The Novices follow the novitiate program and the simple professed have joined the Franciscan religious program at the Friary. Br. Francis goes to his Center and students go to the classes. The life in the novitiate house is busy and everyone works hard and takes responsibility for its betterment.

The novices go to Dar ulSukun on Fridays for their pastoral work and the simple professed go to the Old Age Home (Drigh Road), Lemmen's Home and MALC for their pastoral work on Saturdays. The simple professed also go for spiritual direction.

There are two different groups in the novitiate house, novices and simple professed brothers. All groups stay in the novitiate for two full years for the accompaniment for the new novices. The Director has often expressed that both the groups are following their spiritual and academic programs. He acknowledged that the friars were a great support who helped through academic and other multiple ways for the spiritual growth of the students.



He sometimes shares his worries about the commitment of the candidates. He shares his experience with many students who cannot live their commitment in the area of fulfilling responsibly and proved to be unreliable vocations. Some people left with no clear communication at this stage which created many questions about their authenticity of their vocation.

Fraternal life is focused and lived and the program of the house binds all together every day. There is a close bond in the community and they try their best to be available to support each other. They enjoy celebrations in the community and with other friars in the campus. There are regular masses and prayers, recollection days together with friary students, house meetings and recreation days. All of them work together and almost the whole community is very responsible with their duties. The students are punctual inside the house and outside the house. They are encouraged to make accompaniment possible in prayer times and in other community activities.

Potiuncula Friary Formation House Report

Fr. Moghal Peter is the director of the simple professed brothers whereas Fr. Gul Daniel is the Guardian and community member in the formation house. The director of Friary formation house shared that in the friary the guardian and the director of formation have different roles and both are playing their roles in order to take care of the house and the formation of the student friars as well. He mentioned some work of development in the areas of house maintenance as well. He appreciated the role and contribution of the student friars for the good of the house.

There are three levels of students in the house those who are studying in the Franciscan religious course and the students who follow theological courses at NCIT and a student brother who goes to university for his studies. The formation of the student friars is well organized. They follow prayers, daily masses, education, brotherly relations, accountability, openness, showing respect to elderly friars, sense of responsibility etc. In short, all aspects of formation spiritual, Christian, human are being considered and they are also directed toward new learning and apostolate. Brothers also take spiritual direction regularly every month and they go for their pastoral work at different place. They are being formed in the Franciscan spirit especially through prayer life and prayer days. The spirit of brotherhood is appreciated.

Last three years were a blessing for the custody because a number of the brothers made their simple and solemn professions. The house also had many complications in the past which are settled by the grace of God. The biggest trouble was the water shortage which is solved and the friary has enough water. The solar system has been installed which is a blessing in the time of electricity shortage. Bills are still very high; attention is required to the swimming pool for the good of our garden.

At the moment the friary religious course has a very good teaching staff and there are sufficient courses of philosophy which fulfill the demand at this stage.

The summary of the students entered year wise:

In 2018 there were 14 students at different stages; one made his solemn profession

In 2019 there were 10 students and four made their solemn professions.

In 2020 there were 12 students and one made his solemn profession.

Awareness Programme For Covid-19 Pandemic:-(Dt:08-06-2020 to 11-06-2020)

The Fight against COVID-19, In Lahore our Formation House DAR-UL-NAIM is a Student House in Lahore. The Hostel Student are given awareness about Carona Virus Disease the programme arranged by Fr.Dildar Michael.

The Franciscan Centre serves the disabled children. Most of children come from the poor families according to our policy in the Custody of Pakistan. They come from Christian and Muslim families. We accepted any disabled child without religious reasons because of love and service to disabled children is our mission. The love to the disabled children involves caring, helping and sharing of life. Our staff is happy and thanks to God that we could work among the disabled children.

1. Basic class: Attendance, Body check for any wound, injury or cleanliness of the body. Speechtherapy, Skill of communication other children.
2. Physiotherapy and Exercise for physically disabled children.
3. Learning Urdu and English language, Simple mathematics, Drawing and Painting. Music class. Natural adventure.
4. Art work. Indoor, Outdoor games

Good point.

1. Children are happy and growing with other children because they also need companions of friends. It is very important for human growth of children.
2. Our Franciscan Centre makes sure that children feel at home.
3. Some parents cannot pay fee for full year or some months for their children but we could not reject them and continued to give education, exercise and some other facilities for their lives.
4. The salary of the staff is higher than other centers.

The other, a young man Kashif Shahzad, who is a graduate of the Religious Teachers Course at the Pastoral Institute in Multan. He has become an assistant to the Hostel in-Charge where he teaches religion to the hostel residents.
